

Dear Parents and Students,

It is time for Student Council for form for the 2014-2015 school year. Students in grades 5-8 and St. Coletta will choose a homeroom representative and an alternate to represent them on the Council. In addition, students in grades 4-8 will select Student Council officers from grades 6, 7, or 8 candidates. Here are this year's important dates:

Oct. 21-24	Nomination Days
Oct. 27-29	Campaigning
Oct. 30	Assembly with officer candidate speeches
Nov. 4	Election Day for officers/Governor of WI
Nov. 5-10	Campaign and Election for homeroom reps and alternates
Nov. 12	Induction of offers, reps, and alternates after Mass

Please review the Student Council job with your child (ren) and discuss important leadership qualities and how to make a good choice of candidates. If you child is interested in running for a position on Student Council, review with them the commitment needed to serve.

There are three ways to become an official candidate for offers: self-nomination, peer nomination, or teacher-nomination. Nomination forms are available from homeroom teachers or the school office. Nomination forms are due to *Mrs. Warner* by 2:30 on Friday, October 24. Please note that certain officer positions are grade specific and have detailed qualifications. It is imperative to note that teachers are NOT required to sign a student's nomination form. Students should ask teachers they feel will know them and can vouch for their ability to lead. Classroom reps do not need nomination forms—they will be nominated in the classroom after the officer election.

Student Council meetings will be held once or twice each month from 11-11:45 on either Tuesdays or Fridays. The dates will be posted on the school monthly calendar.
