NEW! ReadnQuiz

Who: Students in grades 1st-5th grade

ReadnQuiz™

What: In place of Accelerated Reader this year we are using a new reading incentive program called ReadnQuiz. This is a voluntary reading program that students can choose to participate in. While ReadnQuiz is a smaller version of Accelerated Reader, the idea is the same, with the main goal being that students are reading for pleasure!

How: After reading, students can search the ReadnQuiz website to see if there is a reading comprehension quiz associated with the book. After successfully passing a quiz, students will earn points. As points are earned students will move between points clubs (10 point club - 20 point club - 50 point club - 75 point club - 100 point club - 500 point club).

When: Students are allowed to take ReadnQuiz quizzes during library time and in the classroom with their teacher's permission. The library is also open after school on <u>Tuesday and Thursdays</u> for students to take quizzes as well.

Rewards: After the pleasure of reading a good book, students will be rewarded with point club number tokens, recognition on point club bulletin boards in the library and in the newsletter as well as an end of the year certificate and small treat.

NEW! Battle of the Books (6th - 8th grade)

We have the geography and the spelling bee – now we have a reading bee! We are excited for many middle school students to be competing in Battle of the Books! Students are broken down



Each table closes at a certain time, and bidding for that group is then finished!


Group A closes at 7:15 p.m. Group B closes at 7:30 p.m. Group C closes at 7:45 p.m.


