- Principals, Religious Education Directors, Teachers, and Catechists



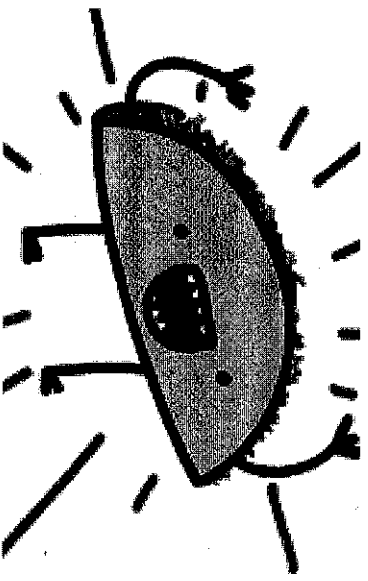

To set up your account

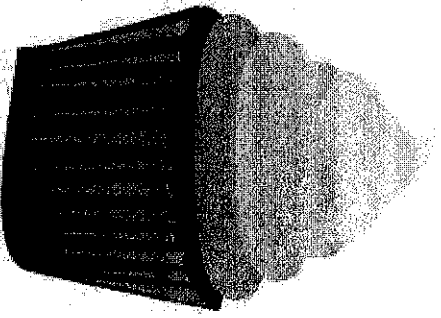

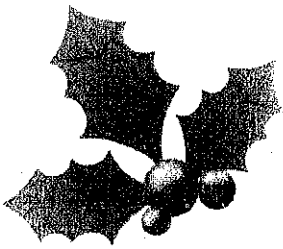

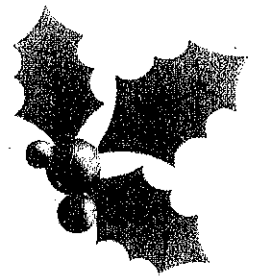
