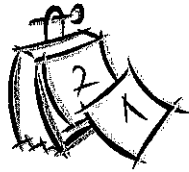

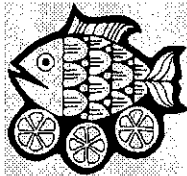

Dear Resident:

The City of Milwaukee, Department of Public Works is hosting a public involvement meeting. The purpose of the meeting is to provide information and solicit input from the public and other project stakeholders on the proposed roadway improvements of West Lloyd Street. The project limits are on West Lloyd Street from North 60th Street to West Lisbon Avenue. The proposed construction project is currently scheduled for 2016.

The meeting will be held on Monday, December 8, 2014 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Washington Park Senior Center, 4420 West Vliet Street. Representatives from the City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works will be available to answer questions. The meeting is an "Open House" format without a formal presentation. Project related sketches and plans will be displayed at the meeting.

Two other public involvement meetings for the proposed project were previously held at the Hi Mount Community School on April 12th, 2012, and October 3rd, 2012. It is anticipated this will be the final public forum for the public to provide input and feedback about the proposed improvements planned for West Lloyd Street prior to the anticipated construction in 2016. 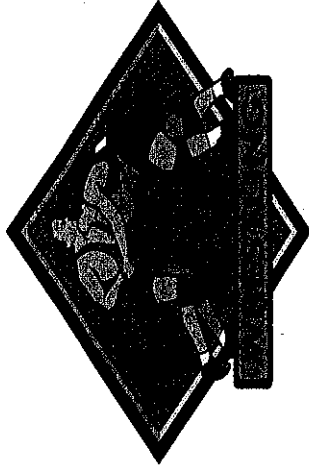

The proposed project will consist of removing the existing roadway pavement and replacing it with new concrete pavement. All curb, gutter and driveway approaches will be replaced as well. The sidewalks will be replaced as necessary due to poor condition and to ensure American with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance.

The roadway width will remain 40 feet between North 60th Street and North 46th Street. The roadway width between North 46th Street and West Lisbon Avenue will be changed from two 32-foot median divided roadways to a 37-foot westbound roadway and a 29-foot eastbound roadway, divided by a 6-foot wide median. Sidewalk will also be added to the south side of West Lloyd Street from North 46th Street to West Lisbon Avenue, along Washington Park. The proposed roadway design will eliminate parking on the south side of the road and reduce driving lane widths from 12 feet to 11 feet to provide a 5-foot striped bicycle lane in each direction.
