"Let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus" (1a-2b).


We have had a number of conversations this year with faculty and students alike, on how we both work together and individually to persevere - in our studies, in our faith lives, and in the day to day.

Perseverance can also call forth, however, nothing more than an inner peace and patience to endure. Rather than feel anxious managing all we have to do and have yet to accomplish, Scripture reveals that Jesus himself sought balance through prayer and waited on God's timing. As is true in work, daily schedules, and indeed our spiritual lives, sometimes we are simply called to wait and to trust, all while carrying on in our efforts to the best of our abilities. This, too, is surely perseverance.

This week we share with you a prayer from St. Teresa of Avila in hopes that it allows for reflection in your own life of how "perseverance" may perhaps take on another meaning - waiting patiently for God's timing of movement in our lives and trusting our role within that to endure; all while fixing our eyes on Jesus.

<u>ATTENTION CHILDREN'S CHOIR FAMILIES</u> - The following are important reminders for picking-up from choir practice, along with a few "tweaks" to ensure all children are safely dismissed. Choir ends promptly on Tuesdays AT 3:30pm. Students are dismissed 1 of 3 ways:

- 1) A parent may come and physically pick up your student in the church at 3:30pm,
- 2) A choir staff member will walk all PAL students to PAL who are scheduled to go there,
- 3) A choir staff member will walk all remaining students to the school parking lot where an approved adult would pick them up. Any child without a parent present to pick them up will be brought to PAL at that time to ensure they are supervised after choir. PAL does have a small fee for childcare which parents are billed monthly.
