Highlights included a 1st Place Team trophy for Sebs K-3 Division team, a 3rd Place team trophy for Sebs K-6 Division team and a 3rd Place team trophy for Sebs K-12 Division team. Individual top ten finishes included a 5th place finish for Serafina Stephenson in K-3, a 9th place finish for Vin Stephenson in K-6 and a 6th place finish in the K-12 division for John Cayen.

The K-3 team was made up of Leo Rowen, Cooper Rowen, Serafina Stephenson, Marik McKenna, Rayven Dodd and Zachary Klarer. Michael Whitney, Ben Kayser, Reed Burzynski, Keegan Madigan, Vincenzo Stephenson and Malachy Kennedy represented Sebs in the K-6 division. Ericanna Mabbett, Patrick Whitney and John Cayen competed in the K-12 division made of mostly high school players.

Alumni Aaron Gorman and Tyler Mabbett played for Marquette University High School who earned a 2^{nd} Place trophy in K-12.
