NEW STANDARDIZED TESTING PROGRAM THIS SCHOOL YEAR – Like our public school friends, we will give our students the Wisconsin Forward Standardized Test. All students in grades 3-8 will take the Wisconsin Forward Standardized test in April/May. To prepare for the Wisconsin Forward test, we used Computer class time in grades 3-8 this week to go over the student instructional videos so students are comfortable with the testing format.

Next, we will have students practice the Wisconsin Forward exam, also in computer lab. Practice test sessions will be Monday, April 4, Thursday April 7 and Friday April 8. Actual student test sessions will begin Tuesday April 12 in the computer lab. Parents in grades 3-8 will get Wisconsin Forward Test information after Easter.
