POPULAR RECIPE – Several people asked for the recipe for the sandwich that was served for the adult lunch on High Interest Day and it was suggested that it be published in the newsletter. Here it is:

HIGH INTEREST DAY SUB SANDWICH:

Herb Cheese Spread

- 1 large clove garlic
- 1 small onion
- 1 (8 oz) package cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup unsalted butter, softened
- 1/4 cup parsley
- 1/4 cup chives
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- dash hot pepper (excluded for HID lunch)

In food processor with steel blade inserted, chop garlic and onion. Add cream cheese, butter, parsley, chives, salt, pepper & hot pepper sauce (excluded for HID lunch). Mix until blended. Chill overnight.

Spread both sides of croissant or roll with herb cheese. Place alfalfa sprouts and roast beef (also used black forest ham and peppermill turkey) on each half. Wrap individually in plastic wrap and refrigerate one hour or up to one day in advance.
