SPRING CONCERT DETAILS – Tuesday May 12 is our Spring Concert – “We Haz Jazz”. The concert begins in church at 6:30. Various grade level combinations will sing during the evening, the middle school choir will sing, and students will perform during the prelude. An all student finale with grades 1-8 will close the performance. Grades K4 & K5 can join the finale from their seats with parents. All students need to be in attendance. Student dress for the concert is holiday or Sunday/Holiday best. No shirts with pictures or writing/slogans, jeans, sports jerseys or t-shirts allowed. School dress code applies – no short skirts, low tops, bare midriffs or sandals, etc. **3rd & 4th Grade** – please wear all black with special white gloves.

Church doors will open promptly at 5:45. Students will report to the church with their families between 6:10 – 6:25. They should leave all coats and possessions in church with their families. Students will then be called to report to their classrooms from church by Mr. Hohl. Again, do not report directly to classrooms – the school will be locked. Stay in church until called between 6:10 -6:25. When students go to classrooms, they should leave all coats and personal items in church with parents – they will not be able to go back to the classroom after the concert. Parents should monitor student behavior – no running, no roaming around, no food, etc. – this is church and we need to demonstrate appropriate behavior. It is especially important to keep young children away from the altar platform. Also, do not sit on the floor in the aisles of church, since classes will be moving in and out of church and the aisles will be used in the finale. After the finale, students will be dismissed to find their families. The only exception to this is K4 & K5 - they will find their families after their performance.

A special Concert Prelude performance will take place from 6:00 – 6:30. Those students should report to the multipurpose room at 5:50. Middle school choir students will sing toward the beginning of the concert but should meet in the classrooms with the rest of the students. The balcony will be open for extra seating and we ask that the audience squeeze together to allow seating for the capacity crowd. Please avoid the front row – that is marked and was purchased at the parish auction. The Spring Concert is a great way to end the school year and focus on our students’ music education. Invite friends and family to enjoy our “We Haz Jazz”.

STOCK MARKET SIMULATION RESULTS - Every year St. Sebastian School 7th and 8th graders participate in the Stock Market simulation in participation with Economics Wisconsin. This year we have a top ten finisher in the Middle school division - the group is led by Eighth grader Tony Yang and includes Maria Wall, Jhaquilla Wicks and Tanner Parpovich. They took \$100,000 and had a gain of 8.69%, which is \$8,687.63. Another group that deserves recognition is an Eighth Grade group that came from a \$2,000 loss to gaining \$7,000 in the last week. They finished 24th in the middle school division, but 1st in the weekly ranking for improvements. This group is made up of Lily Lustig, Jaymie Weigel, Gabe Bohlmann, and Marcus Tarkington.
