END-OF-THE YEAR ACTIVITIES – A variety of activities and schedule changes are upcoming:

- K5 Graduation – 9:00 AM in the church hall on Friday, June 3. Friday June 3 is the last school day for K4 and K5
- 8th Grade Graduation – 4:00 in church on Saturday, June 4th. 8th grade will practice Friday, June 3 at 11:00 AM in the church, then be dismissed for a picnic. Friday, June 3 is the last day for 8th grade
- Final All School Mass & Dismissal on Friday June 10 at 8:15 a.m. Students should report directly to church. Students will receive their report cards directly following the prayer service in church. Dismissal for summer vacation will be at approximately 9:45 AM.

NEXT FRIDAY PROCEDURES – Friday, June 10, is our last day of school. On Friday, students do not report to school. Instead, they should go directly to church. Church will be open at 7:45 AM for arrival, and students must report there by 8:10 AM. The mass will start at 8:15 AM. The students should sit in their usual places with their teachers. Parents are welcome to join them. After Mass, we will have a few student and teacher awards and announcements. Then teachers will hand out report cards. After that, at approximately 9:45 AM, students are dismissed for the summer. There will be no mass on Wednesday, June 8.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS – Reminder, school uniforms should be worn through Thursday, June 9.

FOURTH QUARTER GRADES & REPORT CARDS – Grades for the final grading period close soon. All financial obligations must be current or your child's report card will not be released. Please be sure your payments to the school, the parish and PAL are up to date. Other costs include library lost book fees, cafeteria balances, and textbook damage or lost books!
