The best day of the year! Don't worry – there are still opportunities to volunteer!

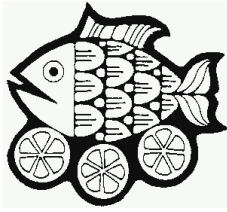
