History of Seton Catholic Schools

In 2014, Archbishop Jerome ListECKI called for a synod to prioritize activities for the Church in southeastern Wisconsin for the next 10-15 years. One of the Pastoral Initiatives the synod created is a focus on Catholic education in Milwaukee. Archbishop ListECKI formed a Task Force to develop recommendations for the Catholic elementary schools in the city of Milwaukee. The Task Force, along with a Design Team composed of principals and school finance people was organized in early 2015. Through their hard work, Seton Catholic Schools came to life. Seton Catholic Schools was created as a new 501c3 in November, 2015.
