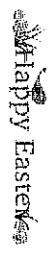

9:30-9:40 – Meet and greet with Principal, Mr. Hohl, and Dean of Students, Mrs. Golomski

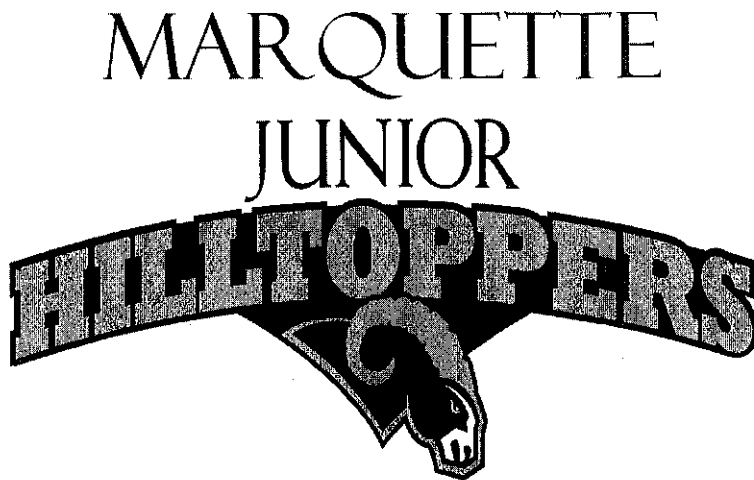
