

Mass/April 6th

(Luke 8:8) *The seed that falls on good ground will yield a fruitful harvest.*

Our mass focus for April 6th and the following weeks will be the theme of Transformation. Easter is now a time for celebration. Please consider a special meal/food, perhaps prepared with your children to celebrate our Lord's resurrection and the joy of Easter. We will provide a few special recipes for you.

Recipe suggestion for this week is Ukrainian Pretzel Cookies. During Lent a simple pretzel was traditional fare in the Ukraine. For Easter the pretzel became sweet, full of butter, eggs and wonderful flavor!

Ukrainian Pretzel Cookies

2 sticks (1 cup) sweet butter at room temperature

1¼ cups sugar

2 egg yolks

Grated rind of 1 lemon

1 tablespoon lemon juice

¼ teaspoon salt

2¼ cups flour

½ cup coarsely ground blanched almonds

Cream butter with 1 cup sugar until fluffy. Stir in egg yolks one at a time, stirring well after each addition. Add the lemon rind, lemon juice and salt. Gradually add the flour, mixing thoroughly.

Chill dough for about 1 hour, then place on a lightly floured surface. Break off small handfuls of dough. Using your fingers, pinch and roll the dough into ropes of about ¼ inch thick and 8 inches long. If you prefer smaller pretzel cookies, make ropes 6 inches long. Form the ropes into pretzels (dough is fragile so will take a little cajoling to shape). Once pretzel is formed, improve on the shape if needed. The dough width should be about ¼ inch or less. Flatten the pretzel slightly on top.

Transfer the pretzel to a buttered baking sheet, placing them about 2 inches apart. Sprinkle them with remaining sugar and almonds. If almond pieces fall to either side, just press them into the sides of the cookie.

Bake at 350 ° F for about 12 minutes or until golden brown. Wait for a minute or two before removing the pretzels from the baking sheet. Let cool on a rack.

Yield: about 3 dozen pretzel-shaped cookies.

Variation: Dough may be flavored with 1 teaspoon of vanilla extract.

Get that crimper heated up, get that volumizer attached, and ready yourself for an evening of inspiring music, celebrating a wholly-regrettable era of fashion.

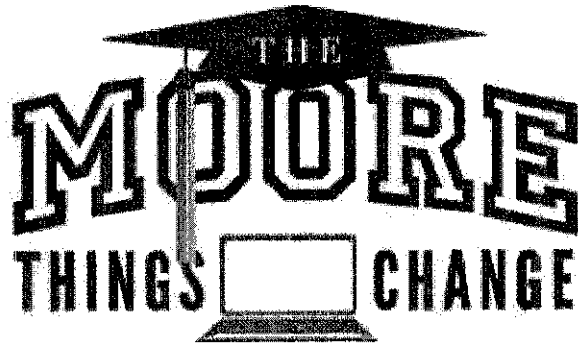
