Join us for a Prelude Concert prior to this at 6:00 p.m. If arriving after 6:00, please be quiet and respectful of students performing in the Prelude Concert. They have worked hard!

General Information:

All students will be participating in the Christmas Concert. Students should be dropped off at the school at 6:00 PM and go directly to their classroom. Teachers will not be in their classrooms until 6:00 PM. Parents should keep their child's belongings with them while watching the concert, as the children will be dismissed directly from the church. Students will not return to the school.

K4 & K5 students will be dismissed to their parents immediately following their performance. We ask that you and your child stay in your pews for the remainder of the concert.

HOT LUNCH ACCOUNT PAYMENTS - If you have a negative balance on your hot lunch account, the Power School system will automatically send you a notice. When you make an online payment to the hot lunch program, the money will be withdrawn from your account immediately. However, the lunch program only receives notice of those payments once a week, and at that time they manually transfer this information to Power School.

To clarify - if you make a payment, it may not be reflected on your Power School account for about a week or so.
